Petoskey Regional Audubon Society (PRAS) uses several electronic means to communicate with and among members, as well as the general public:

a website, PetoskeyAudubon.org;

a Google Group, petoskey-audubon@googlegroups.com;

and **a Facebook page**, Petoskey Audubon.

The Google Group (petoskey-audubon@googlegroups.com) is our new avenue to share information. To join our Google Group you need a Google account, if you don't already have one. You set this up using your existing e-mail, which doesn't have to be a gmail account. Please contact lisahoyt@chartermi.net if you need help with this process.

Our Google Group is for posting & replying about bird-related topics (e.g. recent sightings of interest, or bird-related questions and information). Post by sending an email to: petoskey-audubon@googlegroups.com.

Here are some tips for using Google Groups:

1. If your comments are intended for **only the message sender** (e.g. "Nice seeing you last night"), please use "Reply." "Reply All" sends the message to everyone.
2. **If changing the subject** in a "reply all," please enter **your topic** in the "Subject" box. (e.g. you "reply all" to "Piping Plovers at Sturgeon Bay," but want to share your Scarlet Tanager, please put "Scarlet Tanager near Alanson" in the "Subject" box.
3. Avoid abbreviations. Not everyone knows that PSP=Petoskey State Park or BTBW=Black-throated Blue Warbler.
4. Only a few will know where you live, or where your township (or road) is, so be as helpful as possible for those wishing to re-find the bird(s).
